HAM RADIO IS ON THE MOVE !

The latest callsign figures from the FCC show that 252 novice licenses were issued in the 8'th call area in the month of January. That's up 210% from December's figures. The latest callsign allocations are as follows:

It's official ! Effective 12:01 A.M., March 21, 1987, novice and technician class operators will have phone privileges in the ten meter band (28.1 - 28.3 MHz). Novices will be given all 220 MHz privileges except repeater ownership. This according to ARRL bulletin #NR13A. Yahoo!! Now there's no reason not to get a ham license.
