2. The Field Day site is going to be a little more cramped this year so check with Allen WI8T for station assignments.

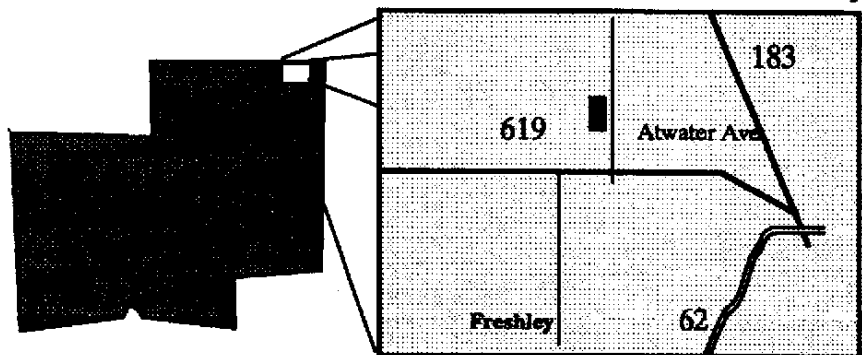
3. The callsign we will use is Allen's call, "WI8T."

4. Setup starting time will be 9 a.m. Saturday morning.

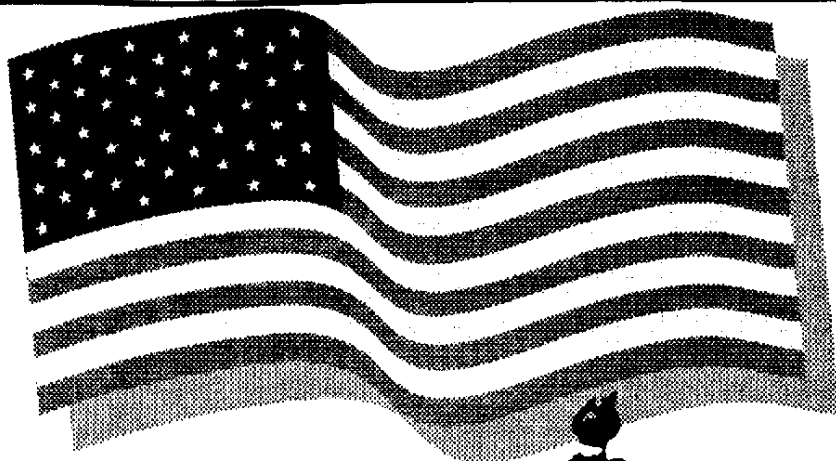
5. There will be a covered dish dinner at 5:30 p.m. Saturday.

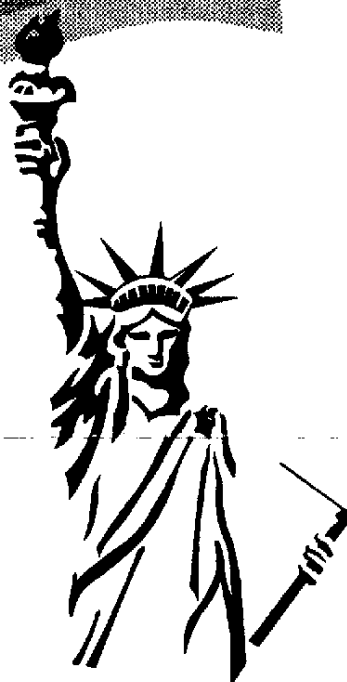

FIELD DAY Q & A'S

Q: I have a Tech license. What frequencies may I operate on during Field Day?

A: You may operate on Extra Class frequencies if there is an Extra Class control operator present at the control point. You may operate on the Advanced frequencies if an Advanced class is there, etc.

Q: What if an unlicensed person wants to operate the station?

A: An unlicensed person can operate as a Third Party as long as a control operator is present AND he contacts only stations that have Third Party agreements with the United States (like North and South America for instance).

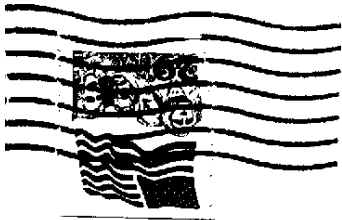
