Field Day begins at 1800 UTC Saturday, June 27th or 2 p.m. local time.


As of this writing, we know the following from Asst. FD Chairman Allen Dicks.


- 4. Setup starting time will be 9 a.m. Saturday morning.



## FIELD DAY Q & A'S

## Q: I have a Tech license. What frequencies may I operate on during Field Day?

A: You may operate on Extra Class frequencies if there is an Extra Class control operator present at the control point. You may operate on the Advanced frequencies if an Advanced class is there, etc.

## Q: What if an unlicensed person wants to operate the station?

A: An unlicensed person can operate as a Third Party as long as a control operator is present AND he contacts only stations that have Third Party agreements with the United States (like North and South America for instance).

We need more persons to take an active interest in selling buttons. If you are going to a hamfest, let Jack know and he will get you some buttons to sell at the hamfest.


